Days 1-8

Day 1 - Arrival in Islamabad

20 Apr | 540 m | No riding

Arrival transfer and full expedition briefing.

Day 2 - Fly to Skardu

21 Apr | Flight 1 hr | Local ride

Weather-dependent flight, motorcycle allocation and familiarisation ride to Manthal Buddha Rock and Satpara Lake.

Day 3 - Skardu to Khaplu

22 Apr | 110 km | 3-4 hrs | Mainly paved

Follow the Shyok Valley to Khaplu Palace and Chaqchan Mosque.

Day 4 - Hushe Valley return

23 Apr | 100 km | 5-6 hrs | Mixed road

Ride into Hushe beneath Masherbrum, Laila Peak, K6 and K7.

Day 5 - Khaplu to Shigar

24 Apr | 130 km | 4-5 hrs

Ride via Sarfaraanga Cold Desert to Shigar Fort.

Day 6 - Shigar to Gilgit

25 Apr | 220 km | 6-7 hrs

Follow the Indus, pause at Jaglot and visit Kargah Buddha.

Day 7 - Gilgit to Karimabad

26 Apr | 100 km | 3 hrs | KKH

Ride beneath Rakaposhi; visit Baltit Fort and Karimabad.

Day 8 - Central Hunza

27 Apr | 50 km | 2-3 hrs

Altit Fort, Altit village and Duikar viewpoints.

Days 9-16

Day 9 - Hopper to Shishkat

28 Apr | 120 km | 4-5 hrs

Hopper Valley, Attabad tunnels, Gulmit and Shishkat.

Day 10 - Upper Hunza

29 Apr | 70 km | 3-4 hrs

Ghulkin, Hussaini Bridge, Passu and Borith Lake.

Day 11 - Khunjerab Pass

30 Apr | Up to 300 km | 8-9 hrs

Ride to 4,693 m when snow, road and official access permit.

Day 12 - Hunza to Shimshal

1 May | 135 km | 5-6 hrs | Rough/exposed

Demanding cliff-cut road into Shimshal; access subject to safety conditions.

Day 13 - Shimshal to Hunza

2 May | 135 km | 5-6 hrs

Return through gorges beside the Shimshal River.

Day 14 - Hunza to Skardu

3 May | 310 km | 8-9 hrs

Complete the riding circuit through the Indus Valley.

Day 15 - Fly to Islamabad; Taxila

4 May | Flight 1 hr | Drive 2-3 hrs

Weather-dependent flight; visit Taxila when timing permits.

Day 16 - Departure

5 May | Airport transfer

Transfer to Islamabad International Airport.

Seasonal operating note

Khunjerab and Shimshal access may be affected by snow, road damage or official restrictions. The expedition leader may reroute, shorten or stop a sector for rider welfare, daylight or road safety.



Hunza provides cultural depth between demanding riding sectors.

Included

15 nights premium twin-sharing accommodation; breakfast, lunch and dinner; Islamabad-Skardu-Islamabad domestic flights; 150cc motorcycle and route fuel; scheduled maintenance; support vehicle, luggage, spares and emergency assistance; expedition leader and English-speaking guide; transfers, listed entrance fees, visa support, mineral water and basic first aid.

Not included

International airfare; visa fee; mandatory insurance covering motorcycle riding; helmet and personal protective equipment; security deposit where applicable; rider-caused damage or repairs; personal expenses, beverages, optional activities and gratuities; costs caused by disruption beyond confirmed contingency arrangements.

Pricing guidance

Indicative range: USD 3,000-6,000 per person. The USD 6,000 level applies to a solo rider. The per-person price reduces as the number of paying riders increases. Final pricing also depends on rooming, confirmed hotels, flight fares and motorcycle category.

Motorcycles and safety

150cc motorcycles are the standard confirmed category. A group-wide upgrade to 250cc or larger motorcycles is subject to availability and quoted separately. Riders require an appropriate licence, an International Driving Permit, suitable protective equipment and insurance covering the confirmed engine capacity and altitude. The Shimshal road includes narrow, rough and exposed sections.
