A carefully paced cultural journey from Karachi to Islamabad, connecting living temples, pilgrimage landscapes, the Indus civilisation and the layered religious heritage of Sindh and Punjab. Sacred-site access remains subject to local permission, worship schedules and community guidance.

Days 1-5

Day 1 - Arrival in Karachi

Arrival day | Airport transfer

Meet the Experience Pakistan team at Jinnah International Airport and transfer to the hotel. After time to rest, receive a private briefing on sacred-site etiquette, photography and the journey ahead.

Day 2 - Hindu heritage of Karachi

Local visits | Light walking

Explore Karachi's living Hindu heritage, including Shri Swaminarayan Mandir and, subject to access, Shri Varun Dev Temple. Visit the National Museum for wider context and conclude near the Arabian Sea.

Day 3 - Hinglaj Mata pilgrimage

Approx. 500 km return | 10-12 hrs | Long day

Depart early along the Makran Coastal Highway for Hingol National Park and the sacred Hinglaj Mata complex. Time is allowed for respectful observation and personal worship before returning to Karachi.

Day 4 - Karachi to Hyderabad via Thatta

Approx. 200 km | 6-8 hrs with visits

Travel east to the stone-carved Chaukhandi tombs, then continue to Thatta for the UNESCO-listed Makli Necropolis and the tile-lined Shah Jahan Mosque before reaching Hyderabad.

Day 5 - Hyderabad to Larkana via Sehwan

Approx. 320 km | 7-8 hrs with visits

Begin with Hyderabad's historic core before following the Indus north. Pause at Sehwan Sharif to understand the region's shared devotional traditions, then continue to Larkana.

Days 6-12

Day 6 - Mohenjo-daro and Sukkur

Approx. 130 km | 4-5 hrs plus site visit

Walk through Mohenjo-daro with an expert guide, examining its street plan, wells, drainage and Great Bath. Continue to Sukkur for an evening beside the Indus.

Day 7 - Sadh Belo and journey to Multan

Approx. 430 km | 7-9 hrs

Visit Sadh Belo, the Hindu temple complex on an island in the Indus, subject to local access and boat conditions. Continue across the plains to Multan for a late arrival.

Day 8 - Multan: sacred layers and old city

Local visits | Light walking

Discover Multan's layered religious history through its old city, historic shrines, bazaars and surviving Hindu heritage. Visits are adapted to current access and community sensitivities.

Day 9 - Multan to Lahore

Approx. 350 km | 5-6 hrs

Drive north through Punjab to Lahore. After arrival, take an orientation walk through the historic centre and prepare for the following day's deeper exploration.

Day 10 - Lahore heritage

Full-day exploration | Moderate walking

Visit Lahore Fort and its celebrated courtly architecture, the Walled City and selected Hindu heritage locations, including Krishna Mandir when accessible. The day also places these sites within Lahore's broader Mughal and colonial history.

Day 11 - Lahore to Islamabad via Katas Raj

Approx. 420 km | 7-9 hrs with visits

Travel to the Salt Range and explore the Katas Raj temple complex, associated with ancient Hindu tradition and centred on its sacred pool. Continue to Islamabad for the final night.

Day 12 - Departure from Islamabad

Airport transfer

Transfer to Islamabad International Airport. If flight timing permits, a short capital orientation may be arranged before departure.

Operating note

Day 3 is intentionally a long pilgrimage day. Temple entry, photography and ritual participation are always governed by local custodians. The sequence may change for closures, religious observances, road conditions or flight schedules.

Included

11 nights twin-sharing accommodation; daily breakfast; private air-conditioned transport and fuel; airport transfers; experienced English-speaking guide/driver; listed entrance fees; local guiding where arranged; bottled water; visa support documentation and journey coordination.

Respectful access

This journey visits active places of worship. Modest dress, removal of footwear where requested, restrained photography and respect for worshippers are essential. Specific temple access cannot be guaranteed in advance and suitable alternatives will be offered when needed.
